AAAM INJURY SCORING COURSE

This course is designed for trauma nurses, coordinators, registrars, physicians, hospital records personnel and researchers. The topics covered: brief history of injury scaling methods; the Abbreviated Injury Scale and uses; coding rules and conventions; methods for assessing the multiply injury patient. The course, which includes a total of 14 hours of classroom work, is divided into lectures and work sessions in which actual hospital charts are used for coding exercises. The course does not teach how to use the ICD. It is designed for those relatively new to AIS coding.
